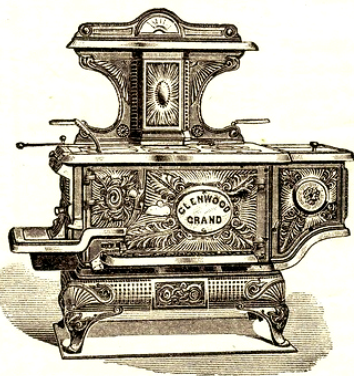

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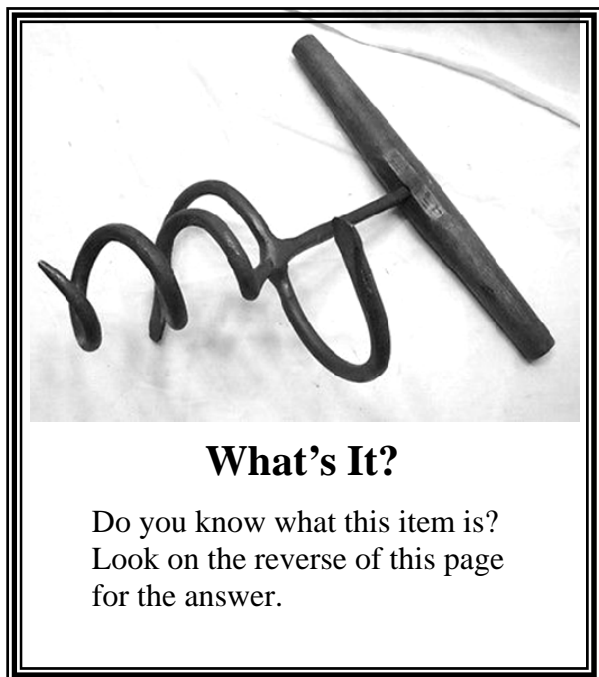
The Best Gravy Dipping Rolls - Two quarts of flour, one half cup of sugar, a piece of butter or beef drippings the size of an egg. Scald one pint of sweet milk, and let it cool; then make a hole in the middle of the flour and pour in the milk and a half cup of yeast, and a teaspoon of salt. Set to rise in a warm place through the night until very light. Knead it and let it rise again. When well risen cut the rolls half an inch thick, shape round, spread on each round a little melted butter, and double over so that the roll is a half-circle; then let it rise very light, and bake. Place the rolls in contact in the baking pan, so that they may keep in shape.

What's It Answer

Sugar Devil Auger : This is a mid-1800's, hand forged auger that was designed to loosen dried fruit or slightly hardened sugar that was either shipped or stored in barrels. The cork screw shaped center section would enter near the center of the opened barrel, then the outer, slightly blunted blades would work with the other to break up or separate the contents of the barrel.



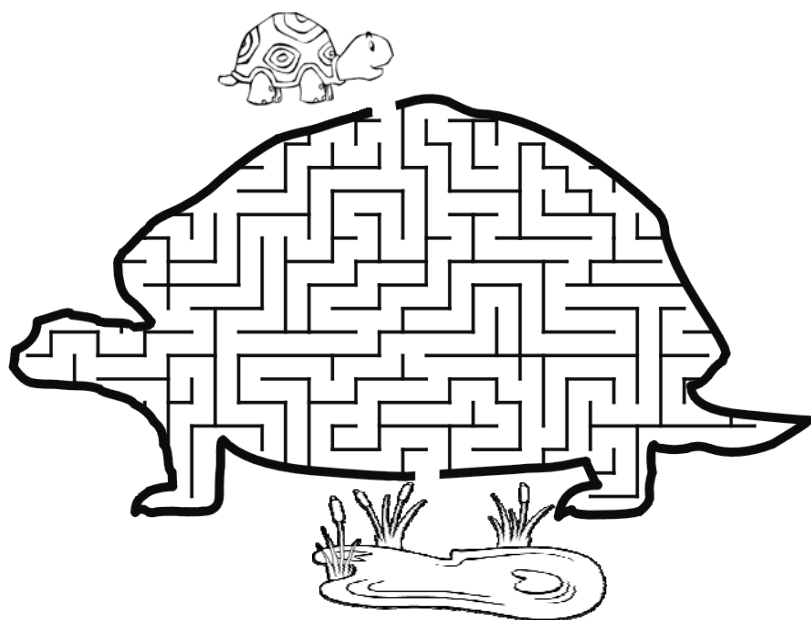
