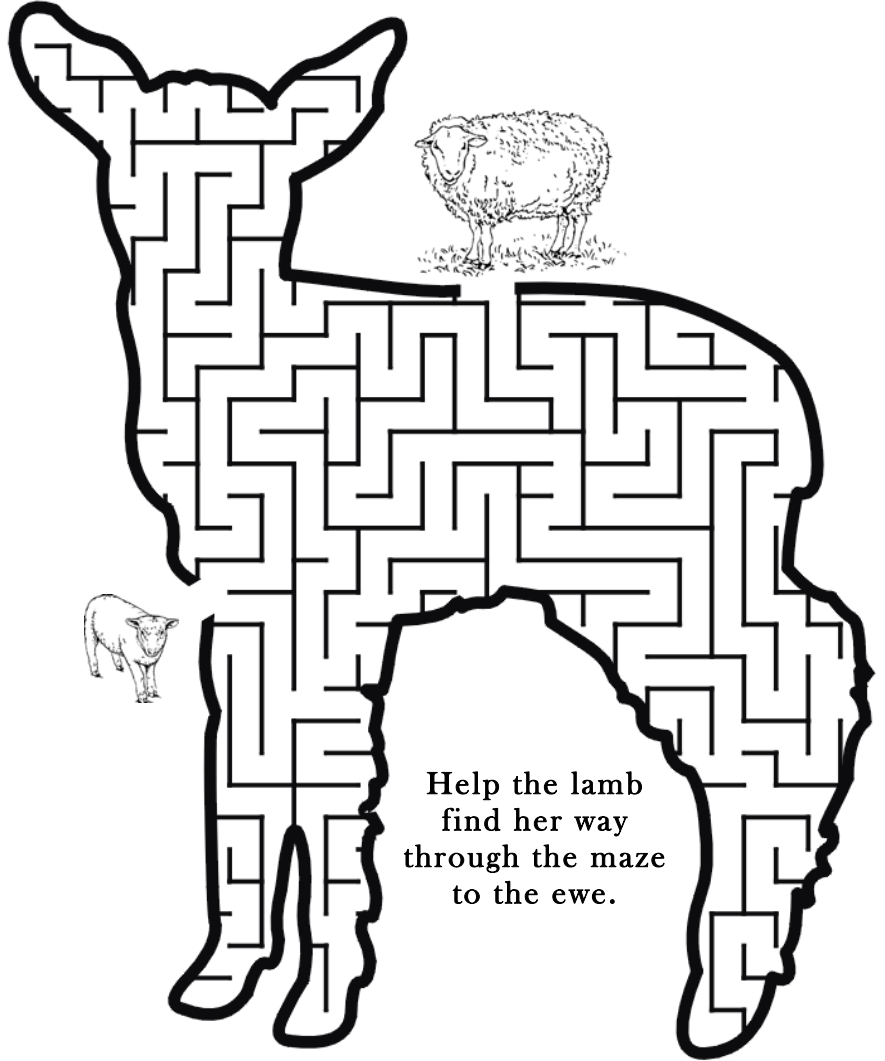
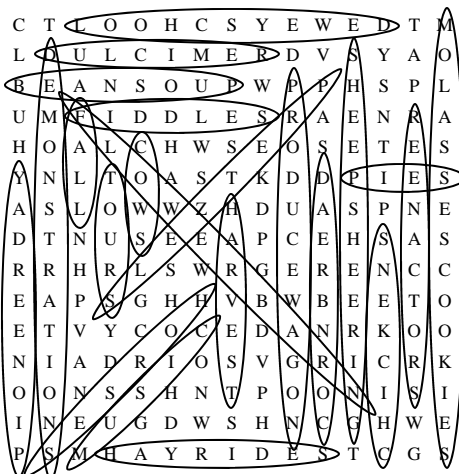


### Aunt Ethel's Sour Cream Sauce
