

**Waterloo Farm and Dewey School Museum**  
**COVID-19 Safety Policy**

**Please read this very important information prior to visiting,  
as your cooperation helps us keep the Farm Museum safe and fun for all.**

- If someone in your party is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or if you believe you have been exposed to the coronavirus, please do not visit at this time. Each visitor/participant at this event must have their temperature taken at the admissions table and be asked about COVID-19 symptoms prior to entering the grounds. All participants/visitors will need to obtain a safety sticker, which is to be worn on your clothing to identify that you have been screened.

**Covid-19 symptoms:**

- Cough
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Muscle or body aches
  - Headache
  - New loss of taste or smell
  - Sore throat
  - Congestion or runny nose
  - Nausea or vomiting
  - Diarrhea
  - Fever or chills

- Please observe a six-foot physical distancing between your party and other parties. Please stay in your group or family unit.
  - We are requiring that everyone wear a mask when you enter a building. Your mask should completely cover your nose and mouth unless doing so would be contrary to your health and safety due to a medical condition.
  - You may bring your own mask, or if you need a mask, we will have disposable masks available at the admissions table for a small donation fee of \$1.00.
  - Masks are not required outside unless you are unable to maintain social distancing due to crowded conditions.
  - Hand sanitizer stations are located at the admission's table, the restrooms, and at the entrance door to the Farmhouse. Staff will be cleaning and disinfecting both the admissions and restroom areas frequently.
  - No handling of artifacts. Avoid touching doors. Volunteers will open doors for you at the entrance and exit of the museum. Doors will be open for easy entrance in all outbuildings.
  - House tours will be conducted for only one family unit at a time, or one group at a time; which consists of a group that has traveled and arrived at the museum together.
  - Food concession orders will be placed at a window and picked up at a window with an eating area available outside. Please observe social distancing in the outside eating area.
  - Electronic payment for the house tour or concessions is available using your credit or debit card and the Museum's Square payment device. (The gift shop will not be open at this time due to fact that the building is a tightly confined space.)
  - Please read the signs posted around the grounds, which indicate other helpful reminders for your safety.

**Code of Conduct and Policies for Visitors:**

Any behavior that is disruptive to the experience of other visitors or is destructive toward exhibits, artifacts, or the general facilities cannot be tolerated. Persons who violate these rules will be asked to leave the premises and may lose membership and/or admittance privileges. Violations perceived as criminal may result in arrest and prosecution.
